## **IL LEAGUE OF CONSERVATION VOTERS RELEASES GENERAL ASSEMBLY ENDORSEMENTS**

The Illinois League of Conservation Voters (ILCV) released their endorsements for the General Assembly today. They are a bipartisan organization devoted full time to its mission of electing a pro-environment political majority in Illinois.

“We are delighted to endorse these exceptional pro-environment candidates from both parties,” says David Herrington, Board Member for the ILCV and Chapter President of Republicans for Environmental Protection. “Environmental issues should not be a partisan issue and we have a great mix of Republicans and Democrats who have promised to actively support environmental legislation.”

Endorsement decisions were based on a questionnaire candidates completed regarding their views on environmental issues as well as a scorecard produced by the Illinois Environmental Council that rates incumbents.

There were two races where both candidates had strong environmental records. The ILCV applauds the enthusiasm of both candidates to proactively support environmental issues, but have chosen not to endorse one candidate over another. Those races include Sandy Cole and Sharyn Elman in House District 62 and Michael Bond and Suzanne Simpson in Senate District 31.

“In certain races there are two candidates with great environmental records running,” says Amanda Espitia, the organization’s Executive Director. “We deeply appreciate the support for conservation from both sides and are very happy to see more and more pro-environment candidates seeking office.”
